

# COMPOSTING IS MANDATORY



## ACCEPTABLE

- **Meat, Bones**
- **Eggs & Eggshells**
- **Fruits, Vegetables, Peels & Pits**  
*(REMOVE STICKERS)*
- **Spices, Salt, & Condiments**
- **Dairy**  
*(milk, cheese, yogurt, etc.)*
- **Moldy, Spoiled, & Expired Food**
- **Cooking Oils, Grease, Fats, Dressings**
- **Human & Pet Hair**
- **Soups, Sauces**
- **Cut Flowers**
- **Fish, Seafood, Shellfish & Shells**
- **Nuts & Shells**
- **Coffee Grounds & Filters**
- **Carbon-Rich Materials**  
*(shredded white office paper, brown paper bags, shredded cardboard, leaves, clean sawdust)*
- **Flour, Sugar, Bread, Pasta, Grains**

*Many other items are compostable but to protect the integrity of the finished compost, please include only the items listed here.*



## NOT ACCEPTABLE

- **Metal & Glass**
- **Wax-Coated Paper Products**  
*(juice/milk cartons or frozen food boxes)*
- **All Plastic including plastic bags**
- **Styrofoam**
- **Compostable Serveware**
- **Sugar & Condiment Packets**
- **Produce (PLU) stickers**
- **Hazardous Waste**
- **Human & Pet Waste**  
*(including cat litter)*
- **Cosmetics**
- **K cups**
- **Pharmaceuticals/ Medications**
- **Dryer & Vacuum Lint**
- **Paper Products**  
*(plates, cups, napkins, paper towels, tissues, etc.)*

*These items will not break down in the compost process or may compromise the quality of the finished compost. Please be diligent in keeping them out of your food scraps.*

## TOWNHOUSE OWNERS & GUESTS

Please put out your compost container Monday and Friday mornings with your garbage and recycling. If during the week you would like to empty your container yourself you can do so by dumping in the compost bin at the far side of the wood shed below the pool parking lot.
